Ningbo Boway Alloy Materials

Project Overview

The Ningbo Boway Alloy Materials solar system is a 4.0 MW rooftop and ground-mounted solar installation located in Ningbo, China. Developed and installed by Boviet Solar for Ningbo Boway Alloy Materials, the system delivers renewable electricity directly to the company's advanced alloy manufacturing facilities.

By generating approximately 5.8 GWh of clean electricity annually, the Ningbo Boway Alloy Materials solar system avoids about 5,000 metric tons of CO₂ emissions each year. This reduction is comparable to planting over 83,000 trees annually, saving around 220 million gallons of water, or preventing the burning of approximately 1,370 short tons of coal. Over its 25+ year lifespan, the project will prevent more than 125,000 metric tons of CO₂ emissions, equivalent to permanently removing thousands of gasoline-powered cars from the road. By producing zero emissions during operation, the system reduces the factory's carbon footprint, improves local air quality, and supports China's renewable energy and climate action goals.

Economic Benefits

The Ningbo Boway Alloy Materials solar system produces approximately 5.8 GWh of electricity annually, directly offsetting a major share of the facility's energy-intensive operations. This results in significant reductions in utility expenses, predictable long-term budgeting, and improved financial resilience. Over its operational life, the system strengthens competitiveness and frees up resources that can be reinvested into R&D, workforce development, and new industrial innovations.

Social Benefits

The project reflects Ningbo Boway Alloy Materials' commitment to sustainability and corporate responsibility. Installed by Boviet Solar, the system supported local clean-energy expertise and reinforced the role of industrial companies in advancing China's renewable energy adoption. By leading in clean energy integration, the company sets an example for peers in the alloy and manufacturing sectors, strengthening community and industry engagement around sustainability.

Environmental Benefits (Estimated)

By generating approximately 5.8 GWh of clean electricity annually, the Ningbo Boway Alloy Materials solar system avoids about 5,000 metric tons of CO₂ emissions each year. This is equivalent to planting more

than 83,000 trees annually, saving around 220 million gallons of water, or eliminating the burning of nearly 1,370 short tons of coal. Over a 25+ year lifespan, the project will prevent more than 125,000 metric tons of CO₂ emissions, equivalent to permanently removing over 26,000 passenger cars from the road. The project reduces the factory's environmental footprint, improves local air quality, and supports China's long-term decarbonization goals.
